



## **Oklahoma Awards Correctional Pharmacy Contract to PharmaCorr**

The Oklahoma Department of Corrections (ODOC) recently awarded its statewide contract for pharmacy services to PharmaCorr LLC, a Valitas Health Services company. The contract commenced September 1 and contains renewal options to run through June 2014. PharmaCorr will be providing prescription services to approximately 20,000 inmates in Oklahoma correctional facilities, work camps and private prisons in addition to clinical consultation with ODOC medical staff. Annualized revenue associated with the contract is estimated at \$11 million.

PharmaCorr is one of the largest mail-order pharmacy programs serving the correctional healthcare market. The organization operates distribution pharmacies in Oklahoma City and Indianapolis filling over 20,000 prescriptions each day with purchase volume of more than \$110 million annually. PharmaCorr has been in operation for over 13 years and is authorized to provide mail-order pharmacy programs to the correctional segment. The company's investments in dispensing automation and information technology, coupled with its aggressive pharmaceutical purchasing practices, provide a stable platform for future growth in the institutional pharmacy marketplace.
